

#### Creating Art is my passion.



MEDIUM: Collage made with painted recycled coffee capsules, acrylics and resin.

CONCEPT: Freedom of the seas.

MEDIUM: Mixed media canvas. Made with recycled coffee capsules, acrylics and resin.

CONCEPT: cycles of the sea and moon.

MEDIUM: Mixed media canvas. Made with shells, acrylics, markers and resin.
